- 2 Belated applications will be rejected. Candidates are therefore advised to apply well in time
- 3 No need to send printout of the application

7. SELECTION

- Selection of the candidate will be done based on the rank list which is prepared by calculating the total marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology acquired in the second year only.

8. GENERAL

- Candidates should bring the original of the certificates/marklists at the time of interview/admission.
- The fact that a candidate has been called for interview does not confer on him/her any claim for selection. The admission lists are provisional and subject to confirmation by the University and Admission Supervisory Committee
- The Co-operative Institute of Health Sciences will not be responsible for non receipt or late receipt of applications, interview memos and other correspondence regarding admission.
- If any candidate who is provisionally selected, fails to report to the Officer concerned, on or before the specified time and date, his/her selection stands automatically cancelled without any further information.

Note:- Courses are affiliated under Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur and conducted by Kerala Co-operative Hospital Federation Ltd.

- 3 (i). Admission to the course will be on the basis of merit. Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or equivalent examination recognized by any of the universities in the state of Kerala with 50% marks in physics, chemistry, and biology put together are eligible for admission.
(ii) 50% of the total seats of the courses have been enmarked as Govt quota and) 50% of the total seats of the courses have been enmarked as KCHF quota for BSc MLT, BPT, Bsc. Med. Micro Biology & Bsc. Medical Bio Chemistry Course.
(iii) Eligibility certificate: Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from outside the state of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of qualifying examination from Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of interview.
(iv) Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on 31st December 2024. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed.
(v) The students shall pay the fees for first year of the course at the time of admission which will not be refunded.
4. 1) Remitted fees of First year shall only be refunded if the student discontinue the course before the last date of closing of admission stipulated by the competent authorities.
2) Examination fee is to be remitted as per University Notification from time to time.
3) The fee is fixed by the management as per relevant court verdict and Govt .orders Time to Time
4) Fee is liable to change as per Govt. Direction.
